Free Workshop: Making Every Dollar Count

The Resource Center for Women will hold two workshops in March for its money management program, "Making Every Dollar Count". The first will be held on Tuesday, March 20th, from 6:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. and the 2nd will be held on Friday, March 30th from 9:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. The workshop is free and open to the public (men and women). The workshop will focus on the following money management topics: Setting up systems to pay bills on time, learning what to do when you can't pay cash and how to stretch your dollars. The classes are held in a comfortable, non-intimidating environment that encourages group discussion and interactive learning. The Making Every Dollar Count program is funded by Ameriprise Financial.
